Hello Everyone,

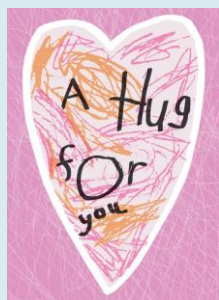
I hope that the new year has started off well for you and that it continues to bring happiness.
